
Ensure you have got revision /homework from all of your teachers for the half term break. It's not a holiday!

#### Instructions for using your Knowledge Organisers

Self-testing You can use your KOs and book in a number of different ways but you should not just copy from the Knowledge Organisers into your book. Below are some possible tasks you could do using your knowledge organisers:

it can you use them for?:
Self quizzing – retrieval
Getting someone to quiz / test you
Look, cover, write, check
Creating revision tools: flash cards, mind maps, revision clocks
Creating summary notes: Cornell notes
Spelling tests
Definition tests  Knowing what knowledge you have looked at so far and what knowledge is going to
be studied – connecting your learning Connect your previous module/topics learning with your current learning.
Carry out additional research  If you are absent, you need to get work from your teacher and use your Knowledge  Organiser to identify the knowledge that you need to study.
Five questions in five minute five times ere are some spaces in this book for you to practise using your knowledge ganisers. When you are using your knowledge organiser to try to learn and member something, write down five key questions and the answers and then use em to test yourself five times.
