The evening will comprise:

1. Preparation for Summer Examinations – Effective Revision Strategies

Research has shown that there are a number of different strategies that students can employ to help them work harder and be the master of their own success. Students can fully commit to their work by avoiding distractions, choosing the most useful tasks (not just the ones they find easy or enjoy the most) and managing their time effectively.

In this session, Mrs Ritchie (Acting Deputy Headteacher) will explain how your child will be supported by school, in partnership with parents, to achieve success in the final examinations.

2. Subject information

An opportunity to hear subject specific information about English and mathematics from the curriculum leaders of these subject areas.

3. Passport to Prom

4. Blue report mentoring
