



# Helping your child to study at home

All teachers will set home learning tasks for your child via Google Classroom. Your child should use their timetable to make sure that they have signed into all of their Google Classes so that they will be able to access all of their work.

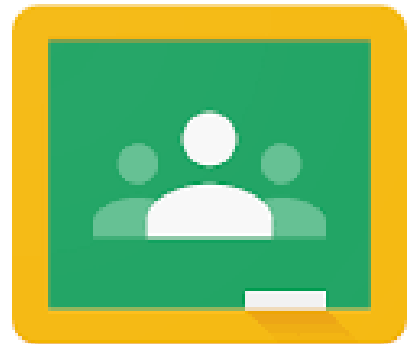
By completing the activities set on Google Classroom, you can be confident that your child will not fall behind with their learning.
