<b>Numeracy Catch-Up</b>

Lunchtime numeracy catch-up	23 Year 7 catch-up students attend the lunchtime sessions. Sessions are designed by a member of the maths team (CMR). They work in 2 rooms with approximately 4 year 9 mentors in each room working with the students. Each room has a member of teaching staff present to oversee the work (JHS, PLT).	£2400

	<p>The topics are covered over several sessions.</p> <p>Usually, the students will watch a corbettmaths video on a given topic. They will then work with the year 9 mentors to answer questions based on this topic.</p> <p>There are also a lot of puzzles and games which are incorporated into the sessions to support and engage the students.</p>
