Dear Parent/Carer,

Please find enclosed our school report for the end of the Autumn first term.

All reports include:

- *'Working at Grade'* Grades run from 1-9 (9 being the highest) and a 'w' indicates working towards this scale.
- *'Predicted Final Grade'* this is the GCSE grade they are likely to achieve if they continue working at their present rate.
- *'Target Grade'* that they should be aiming to achieve or exceed by the end of the year
- *'Attitude to learning'* The grading criteria is A-E (A being the most positive)
- *'Class work'* The grading criteria is A-E (A being the most positive)
- *'Homework'* The grading criteria is A-E (A being the most positive)
- *'Attendance'* 95% is generally considered to be good.
- *'Credits/Debits'* – a total so far for the academic year
