Year 7 Academic Reports

Dear Parent/Carer of a Year 7 Student,

Please find enclosed our school report for the end of the first term.

We will use this information alongside the reading and computed based assessments, completed this term, to group students into teaching groups when they return in January.

All reports include:

- *'Working at Grade'* Grades run from 1-9 (9 being the highest) and a 'w' indicates working towards this scale. In year 7 we would expect many students to just be at the beginning of this scale.
- *'Attitude to learning'* The grading criteria is A-E (A being the most positive)
- *'Class work'* The grading criteria is A-E (A being the most positive)
- *'Homework'* The grading criteria is A-E (A being the most positive)
- *'Attendance'* 95% is generally considered to be good.
- *'Credits/Debits'*

We have decided at this time to not include a *'Target Grade'*. We will work with the first terms data to generate these for January and share them with class teachers and students.

More information on the criteria used to judge attitude, classwork and homework is included with this letter.
