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Year 11 Careers and Post 16 Pathways

Following the continued school closures, I am writing to give you further information regarding work and online resources to support students in their next steps.

Additional resources to support online courses and research in preparation for A Level courses and Apprenticeships have now been made available in the folder area. These can be found in the year 11 folder called Year 11 Free online courses and Further Study. While these are a limited number of new apprenticeships being advertised I would still advise to sign up to the government apprenticeship site to receive notifications of new roles. You may also want to consider alternative routes for September including A Levels or College courses depending on the subjects you are interested in.

Students who will be joining St Joseph's Sixth form have been provided with bridging units of work. Students will need to work though the units in relation to their three subject choices for year 12. This body of work will support students in the step up from GCSE to A Level and provide them with the knowledge to make the best start possible in September.
